

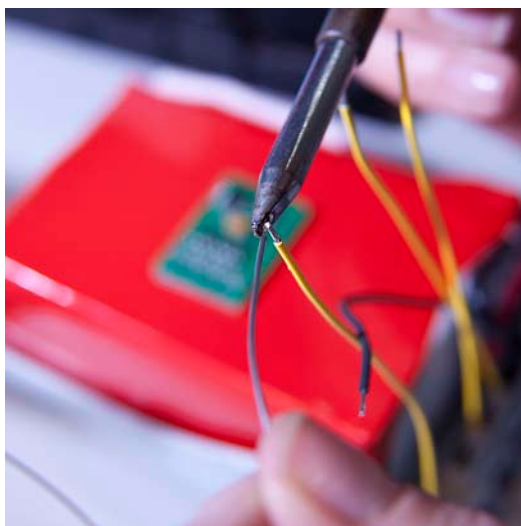


# ASSEMBLY

A part produced at AMB often passes through more than one of our departments: injection moulding, metallising and/or painting. The department that brings them all together is assembly. This is where we assemble and carry out final inspection of the finished product, which is then packed ready for shipping to the consumer or goes on to final assembly.

Having a clear overview and understanding of the entire production process is very valuable. The co-ordination benefits that are gained by gathering everything under the same roof are therefore considerable. Shorter lead times, lower rejection costs, and – not least – reduced environmental impact thanks to less transport, are factors that make this a profitable approach in more ways than one.

The department also carries out a number of post-machining operations, such as ultrasonic welding, heat staking, bonding, soldering and various screw fastening methods. We also carry out resistance measurement, calibration and other forms of inspection prior to packing. After final inspection we can offer traceabil-



ity marking to suit the needs of medical technology customers.

We can even handle the purchasing of component parts for customers. One transaction, one contact – it doesn't get any easier.
